'Berlin-Brandenburg as a hub for seaport hinterland traffic - Marketing' is a two-year project that was partially financed by public funds from the European Union and the State of Brandenburg. It aims at better marketing of the infrastructure, the location potential and the services of regional logistics providers to the major market players in hinterland transport activities of the North and Baltic Sea ports situated in Belgium, The Netherlands, Germany and Poland. The scope of the project work involves the analysis of requirements to sea port hinterland transportation, market analyses specific to target countries, development of promotional tools, country specific information events (road shows) and business meetings in the region Berlin-Brandenburg as well as overall evaluation and dissemination of project results. Around 10 consulting firms/service providers and a dozen supporting project partners are coordinated by W&H on behalf of the logistics network.
